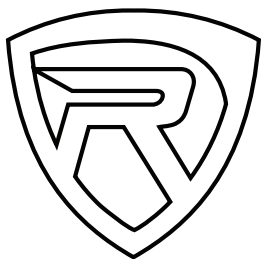

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## ***Powering the Unit***

- Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds
- The unit will turn on and the main screen will be displayed.
- When the engine key is turned to the “OFF” position, the unit will turn off.
- If the unit does not turn on, check to ensure all wires are connected properly. It is strongly suggested you seek out the help of a professional when installing.

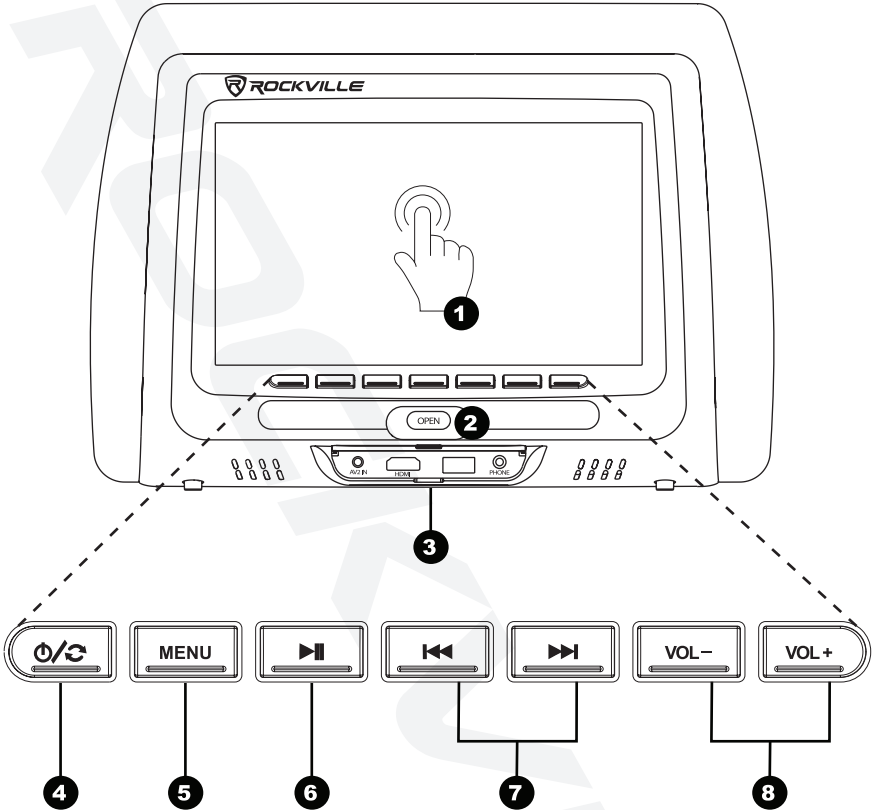

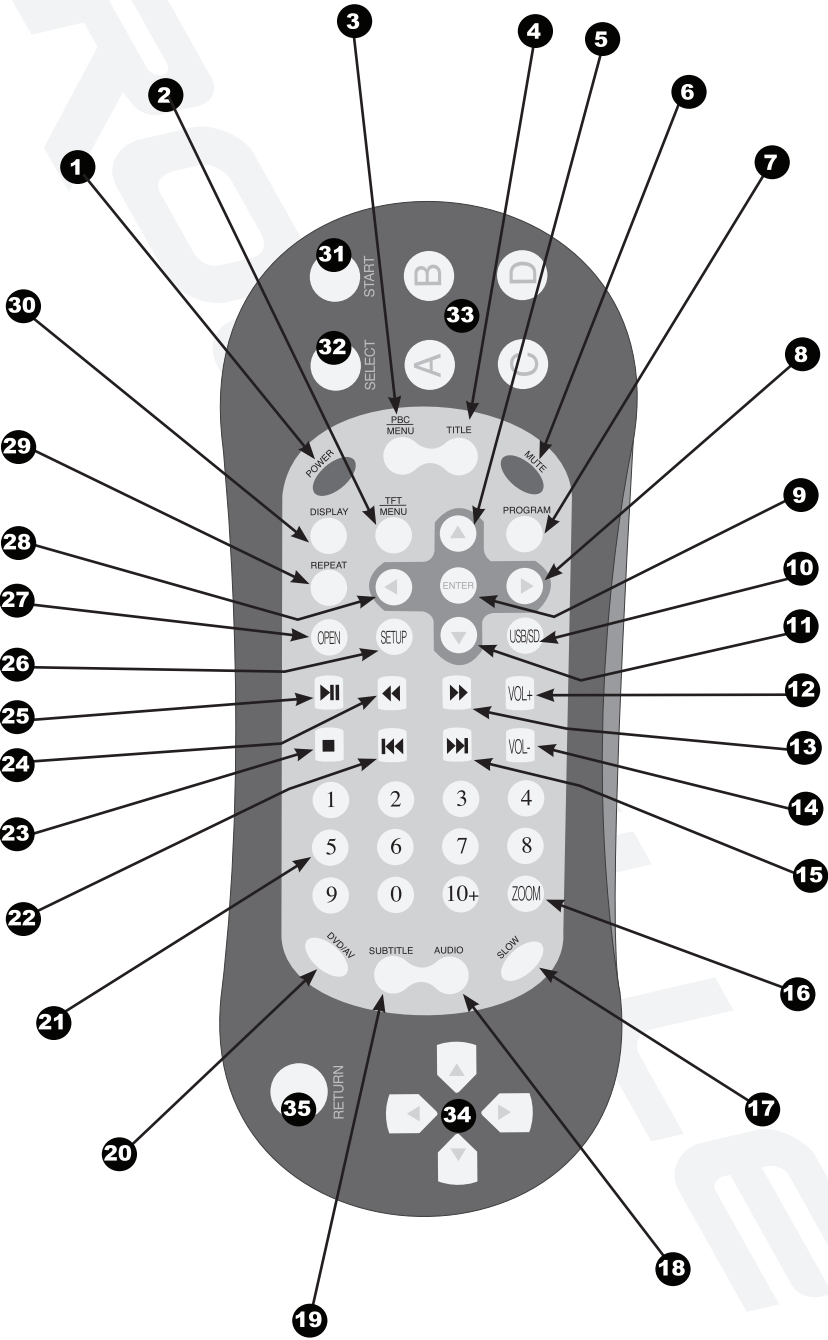

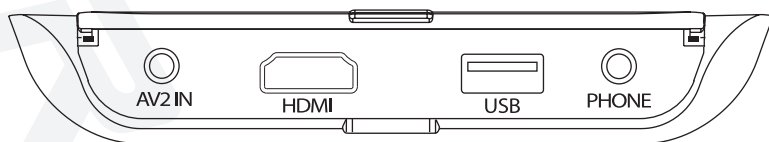


1	Touch Screen	*Touch capabilities only available on the <b>RTSVD961</b> unit (see pg.9 for more information)
2	Open	Open the disc loading tray
3	Media Bay	Various media inputs and outputs are available (See pg.# for more details)
4	Power/Switch	Hold for power on and off, quick press to switch between different inputs
5	Menu	Open the system menu to access settings (see pg.# for more information)
6	Play/Pause	Installation pipes
7	Skip Back/Forward	Previous/Next to skip next
8	Volume Down/Up	Volume up/volume down





1	<b>Power</b>	Turn unit on and off
2	<b>TFT Menu</b>	Access unit settings menu
3	<b>PBC Menu</b>	Setup playback settings
4	<b>Title</b>	Return to the title screen
5	<b>Up Arrow</b>	Navigate up when available
6	<b>Mute</b>	Mute audio
7	<b>Program</b>	Adjust unit functionality.
8	<b>Right Arrow</b>	Navigate right when available.
9	<b>Enter</b>	Select highlighted item.

## DVD Operation

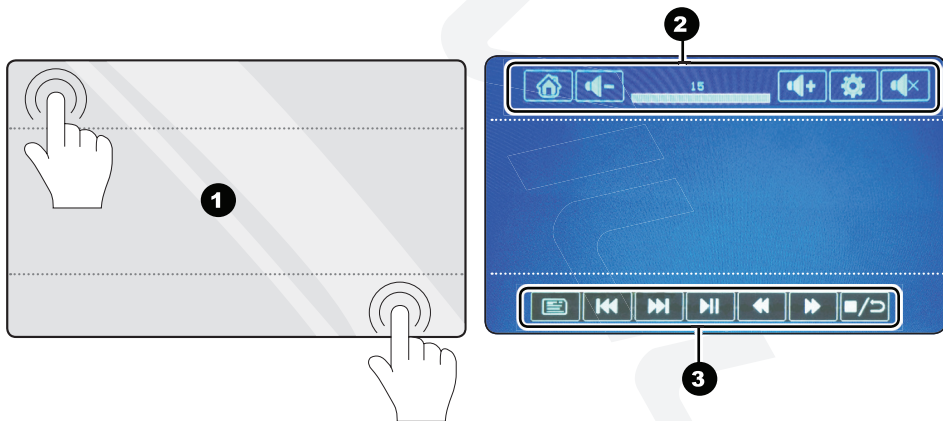
- Insert disc into the slot with the label facing up

- To return to DVD playback press MODE on the unit front panel until DISC is selected
- Use the remote or the unit front panel to control playback

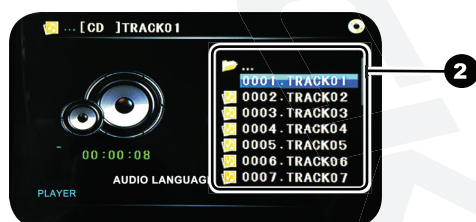
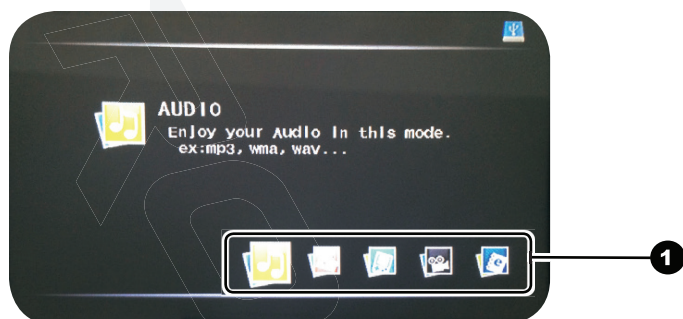

## Touch DVD Controls

1	Touch Points	While in DVD playback only the top and bottom areas are touch compatible
2	Top Menu	Return home, increase/decrease volume, access DVD settings, and mute
3	Playback Menu	The playback menu provides the basic playback options



- 1 Select the type of media you'd like to browse  
Audio/Photo/Games/Video/Books
- 2 Browse folders by selecting them to see their contents or select  ... to return to the previous folder
- 3 Select the desired file to begin playback (See pg.8s for list of supported file types)

## Picture

Fine tune the display settings. Brightness, contrast, saturation, sharpness, hue, and orientation. Adjust manually or use one of the presets found under "Picture Mode".



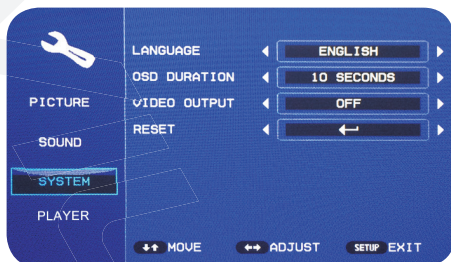
## Sound

Fine tune the sound settings. Bass, Treble, Balance, FM Radio Frequency, IR Radio Frequency, Volume. Adjust manually or use one of the presets found under "Sound Mode".



## System

Change system settings. Language, OSD Duration, Video Output, Reset. OSD Duration changes the amount of time the menu will wait before disappearing from inactivity. Reset restore the factory default settings.

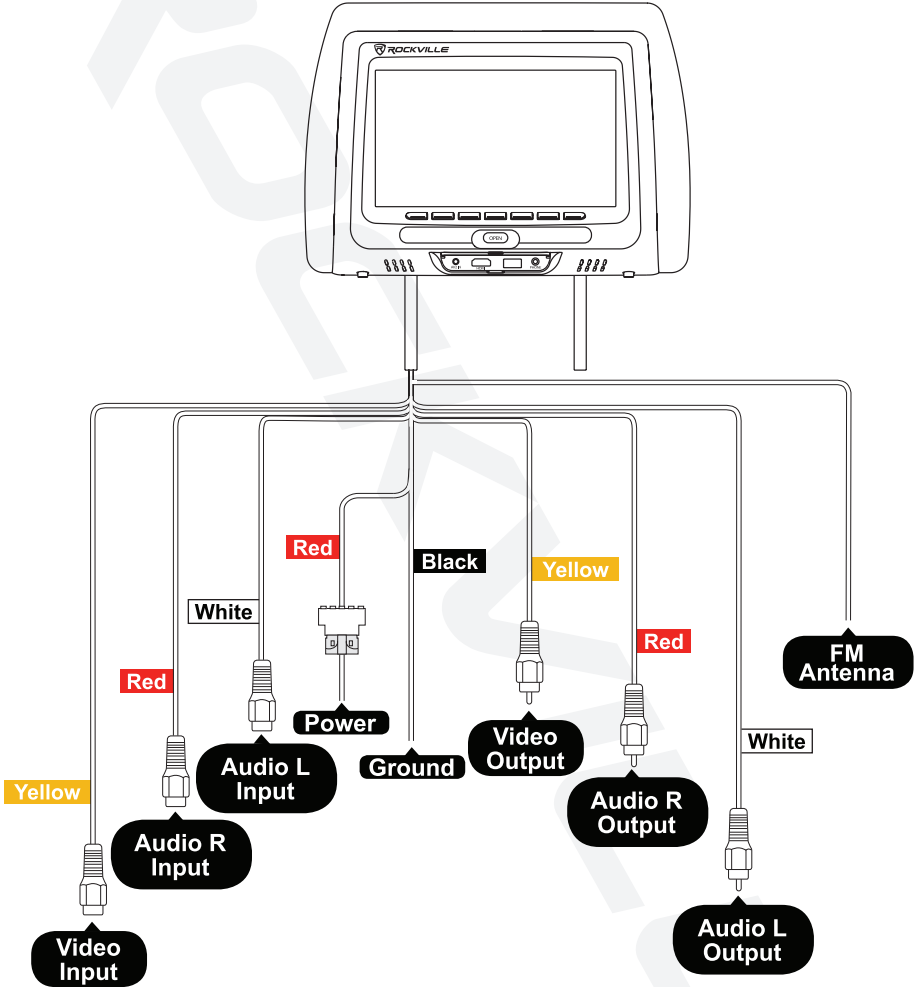


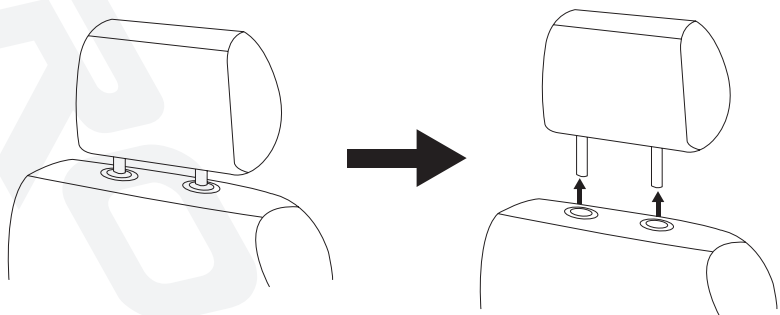
## Player

Adjust disc playback options. TV system, screen save, aspect ratio, password, rating, resume, audio language. TV system switches between PAL and NTSC mode. Use password and rating to set parental restrictions for child use.

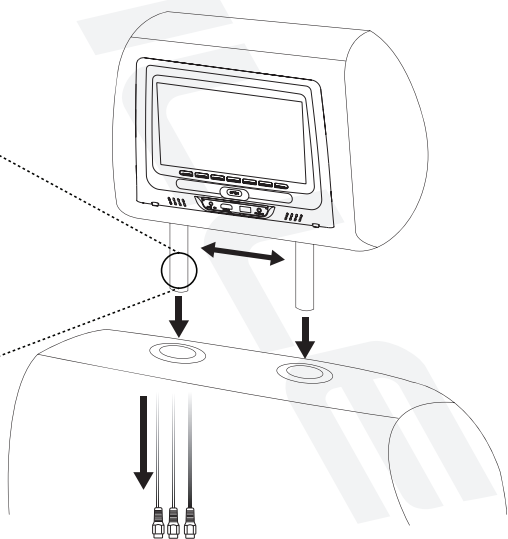
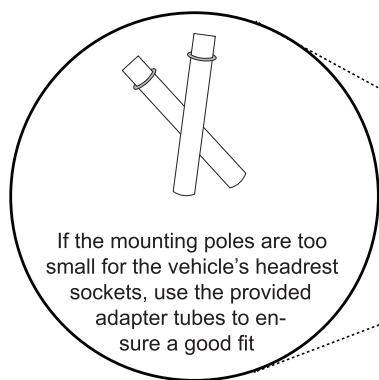


Wiring Diagram





- Remove the existing headrest from the seat
- Adjust the mountings poles of the Rockville headrest unit to fit in the vehicle's headrest sockets
- Feed the wiring through the hole, down to the bottom of the seat (make sure none of the cables are pinched)
- Once the wires are through, finish inserting the Rockville headrest unit it clicks into place
- You can now adjust the height of the unit as you would the vehicle's factory headrest unit
- Refer to the wiring guide for proper connection of wires
