Powering the Unit


- Turn the engine key to the "ACC" or "ON" position
- Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds
- · The unit will turn on and the main screen will be displayed.
- When the engine key is turned to the "OFF" position, the unit will turn
 off.






- · Insert disc into the slot with the label facing up


Change system settings. Language, OSD Duration, Video Output, Reset. OSD Duration changes the amount of time the menu will wait before disappearing from inactivity. Reset restore the factory default settings.




Player


Adjust disc playback options. TV system, screen save, aspect ratio, password, rating, resume, audio language. TV system switches between PAL and NTSC mode. Use password and rating to set parental restrictions for child use.







- Remove the existing headrest from the seat
- Adjust the mountings poles of the Rockville headrest unit to fit in the vehicle's headrest sockets
- Feed the wiring through the hole, down to the bottom of the seat (make sure none of the cables are pinched)
- Once the wires are through, finish inserting the Rockville headrest unit unit it clicks into place
- You can now adjust the height of the unit as you would the vehicle's factory headrest unit
- Refer to the wiring guide for proper connection of wires

Remote control not responding	Replace the battery in the remote control
