

#### **FUNCTIONS**

- 1. **Volume up:** Press and hold to increase volume. During BT playback mode short press to skip to the next track.
- 2. **Volume down:** Press and hold to decrease volume. During BT playback mode short press to skip to the previous track.
- 3. Power/Play-pause: Press for 2 seconds to power on/off. Short press to play/pause current track. While in BT mode short press to answer/hang-up during phone calls. Press for five seconds to reject calls. Press twice to redial the last number.
- 4. **LED indicator:** While in Bluetooth pairing mode the LED flashes alternately orange and blue. The LED will turn off when the device pairs successfully. While charging the LED indicator will be orange. Once the headphones are fully charged the LED will turn blue.



#### CHARGING

- 1. Connect the included micro USB cable to the headphones. Connect the other end to a computer or AC adapter (not included).
- 2. The LED indicator will turn orange during charging.
- 3. Once the unit is fully charged, the LED indicator will turn blue.

#### **LOW BATTERY**

If the battery is low, the headphones will automatically turn off. Please charge at this time. If you will not be using the headphones for a long time, please charge at least once a month to maintain the battery.

#### **BLUETOOTH PAIRING**

- 1. Turn on the headphones by pressing the power button for 2 seconds. The LED will flash blue. The headphones will automatically enter pairing mode and the LED indicator will flash alternately orange and blue.
- 2. Keep your Bluetooth headphones and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
- 4. Make sure Bluetooth is active on your device and that it is discoverable.
- 5. Look for "Rockville" in your list of available devices and select it.
- 6. If you are asked for a PIN or pass code, enter "0000".
- 7. If pairing is successful you will hear a voice prompt and the indicator LED will turn off.

**Please note:** In order to pair a new device, you must unpair the currently paired device. After disconnecting, turn the headphones off and on to re-enter pairing mode.

#### **CONNECTING MULTIPLE PHONES**

- 1. Disconnect the first phone and restart the headphones to enter pairing status. Connect the second phone following the pairing procedures above. Once the second phone has been connected, go to the BT section of the first phone and select Rockville from your list of available devices to reconnect.
- 2. If you are listening to music on the first phone and wish to switch to the second phone, simply turn off the music function on the first phone and turn on the music function on the second phone.
- 3. If you are making a call on the first phone and a call comes in on the second phone:
  - A. Press the power button for 1 second to reject the call.
  - B. Press the power button once to end the current call and answer the incoming call.
  - C. Press the power button twice to put the current call on hold and answer the incoming call. To switch between the calls, press the power button twice. To end one of the calls, press the power button once.

#### **USING AS WIRED HEADPHONES**

- 1. Connect one end of the included 3.5mm cable to the 3.5mm jack on the bottom of the right ear cup.
- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to your external device's 3.5mm headphone jack.
- Use the controls on your external device to control audio playback and volume. The buttons on the headphones as well as the microphone will be inactive during wired use.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
I can pair my headphones to a Bluetooth device but I cannot hear any music.	Make sure your device supports the A2DP profile.     Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.     Unpair your headphones and re-pair to the device.
The headphones will not go into pairing mode.	Turn the headphones off. Now press the power button for 2 seconds to turn on the headphones and automatically enter paring mode.  Check that the headphones are charged.
My Bluetooth device is unable to pair with the headphones.	Device may be paired to another paired BT devices.     Check that the devices Bluetooth feature is turned on.     Keep your headphones and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.     Turn the headphones off. Now press the power button for 2 seconds to turn on the headphones and automatically enter paring mode.


