



OPERATION

Power ON: Hold down the Power button for 3 seconds. The unit will automatically enter into Bluetooth pairing mode.

Bluetooth

1st Time Pairing: Power ON the unit. The blue mode indicator LED will flash quickly. Now look for and select ROCK LAUNCHER on your Bluetooth device's list of available devices. If pairing is successful, the blue mode indicator LED will blink slowly.

Unpairing: To unpair current device and return to paring mode, press and hold Play/Pause. The blue mode indicator LED will flash quickly indicating that the unit is in pairing mode.

Automatic Pairing: The ROCK LAUNCHER unit will remember and automatically pair with previously paired devices.

True Wireless Stereo (TWS)

If you have a pair of ROCK LAUNCHER speakers, you can set them up as a 2.0 stereo speaker system. Please make sure the units are no more than 16ft away from each other during pairing.

TWS Pairing: Hold the Power button down on the first speaker for 3 seconds. Then hold the Play button down for 3 seconds to enter into Stereo Paring mode. At this time the blue mode indicator LED will blink quickly. If the speaker is already paired with a Bluetooth device, hold down the Play/Pause button to disconnect the speaker from the current device and return it to pairing mode.

2 Hold down the Power button on the second speaker for 3 seconds. The speaker will automatically search for the first speaker and then connect with it. Once it has successfully connected, the blue mode indicator LED on the second speaker will blink steadily.

3. Now look for and select ROCK LAUNCHER on your Bluetooth device's list of available devices. If pairing is successful, the blue mode indicator LED of the first speaker unit will blink slowly.

TWS Unpairing: Hold down the Play/Pause button for 3 seconds to exit TWS mode,

Automatic Pairing: Once TWS pairing has been achieved, the ROCK LAUNCHER unit will remember previously paired devices and automatically go into TWS mode.

Playback Controls

Once paired, all playback functions (play/pause, volume, tracks) can be controlled from your playback source (ex. phone/mp3 player) without ever having to touch the unit. You can also control playback from the ROCK LAUNCHER. Please note, if you are using an iPhone, iPad, or iPod the volume controls are synched so that if you raise the volume on your device, it will raise the volume on the unit and vice versa. If using an Android device, you will need to adjust the device's volume and the ROCK LAUNCHER's volume independently.

Music: Press the Play/Pause button to begin or pause music playback,

Volume Control: Press the + button to increase the volume or press the - button to decrease the volume

Skip Songs: Hold down the + button for the next song. Hold down the - button for the previous song.

Answering/Ending Calls: Press the Play/Pause button to answer incoming calls. Press the Play/Pause button to end the conversation. To reject an incoming call hold down the Play/Pause button.

Auxiliary

Use the included 3.5mm to 3.5mm cable to connect non Bluetooth external audio devices. The unit will automatically switch to auxiliary mode and the mode indicator LED will steadily blink red.

Music Playback/Skip Songs: Use your device to control Play/Pause and skip track functions

Volume Control: You will need to adjust the device's volume and the ROCK LAUNCHER's volume independently,

Charging

Connect the included micro USB cable to the micro USB port at the rear of the unit. Connect the other end to an AC adapter (not included) or a computer USB port. Normal full charge time is 3-4 hours. The mode indicator LED will remain solid green while charging and will turn off once the unit is fully charged. If the

speaker is powered on and is inactive for more than 10 minutes, it will automatically shut off.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Power	Make sure the battery is fully charged. If not, plug the unit to a USB power source and charge for 3 – 4 hours for a full charge.
Bluetooth pairing fails	Make sure both devices are turned on and that your BT device is discoverable. Make sure you've selected the proper source. Make sure the BT device is within 5ft of the unit. Move both devices away from other BT devices, microwaves, wireless routers, and other electronics. Make sure the unit is not paired to another device.
TWS pairing fails	Make sure both devices are disconnected from any previously paired devices. Turn-on the first unit and follow the TWS pairing steps. Make sure the speakers are no more than 16ft apart during the pairing process.
